Form W-4 (2015)

Purpose. Complete Form W-4 so that your employer can withhold the correct federal income tax from your pay. Consider completing a new Form W-4 each year and when your personal or financial situation changes.

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Exemption from withholding, if you are exempt, complete only lines 1, 2, 3, 4, and 7 and sign the form to validate it. Your exemption for 2015 expines. February 16, 2016. See Pub. 505, Tax Withholding and Estimated Tax.

Note. If another person can claim you as a dependent on his or her tax return, you cannot claim exemption from withholding if your income exceeds \$1,050 and includes more than \$350 of unearmed income (for example, interest and dividends).

Exceptions. An employee may be able to claim exemption from withholding area if the employee is a dependent, if the employee.

- Is age 65 or older,
- · Is blind, or
- Will claim adjustments to income; tax credits; or

The exceptions do not apply to supplemental wages greater than \$1,000,000.

Basic instructions. If you are not exempt, complaint the Personal Allowances Worksheet below. The worksheet on page 2 further adjust you withholding allowances based on itsmized deductions, certain credits, adjustments to income, or two-earners/multiple jobs situations.

Complete all worksheets that apply. However, you may claim fewer (or zero) allowances. For regular wages, withholding must be based on allowances you claimed and may not be a flat amount or percentage of wages.

Head of household. Generally, you can claim head of household fling status on your tax return only if you are unmarried and pay except than 50% of the costs of keeping up a home for a flam 50% of the costs of keeping up a home for yourself and your dependentity or other qualifying individuals. Tax credits. You can take projected tax credits into account in figuring your allowable number of withholding allowaness. Credits for child or dependent care expenses and the child tax credit may be claimed using the Personal Allowaness Worksheet below. See Pub. 505 for information on

Norwage income. If you have a large amount of norwage income, such as interest or dividends, consider making estimated tax payments using Form 1040-ES, Estimated Tax for individuals. Otherwise, you may owe additional tax. If you have pention or annuity income, see Pub. 505 to find out if you should adjust your withholding on Form W-4 or W-4P.

Two earners or multiple jobs. If you have a
working spouse or more than one job, figure the
total number of allowances you are entitled to claim
on all jobs using workshapts from only one Form
W-4. Your withholding usually will be most accurate
when all allowances are claimed on the Form W-4
for the highest paying job and zero allowances are
diamed on the others. See Pub. 505 for details.
