⁴ Child care providers are required to report any incidents involving a child in its care, including on- and off-site activities, where treatment by a medical professional was necessary. Figures reported do not include instances where a medical professional examines a child but determines that either no injury occurred, or treatment was not necessary.

⁵ During the reporting period, the Tennessee Department of Children's Services (TDCS) substantiated one instance of child abuse involving physical abuse. Six (6) cases are pending a final determination by TDCS upon completion of due process. This report may be revised depending on the final outcome of these cases.

⁶ During the reporting period, TDHS investigated one (1) fatality involving a toddler in the care of a licensed child care center. The child care center voluntarily surrendered its license and is no longer in operation.
