Program Implementation

Carey Counseling will utilize a team to provide program services, and when possible the services will be provided in the community. Referrals and screenings will be available on-site in court, as well as other community locations based on youth and family preferences. Interventions will be tailored to best meet the needs of the youth and family. A Care Coordinator will provide linkage and coordination to available community resources, including individual and/or group therapy. The Care Coordinator will also monitor youth involvement in services and help to implement new services to meet the youth's needs. A Certified Peer Recovery Specialist will provide peer driven support and intervention.

An Employment and Education Specialist will provide education and employment monitoring and support.
