Justice endorsement eligibility requirements

- Current certification as a CPRS
- Self-identification of having lived experience of justice involvement
- Desire to provide peer support to Tennesseans who are justice-involved across many settings (jails, communities, treatment programs, psychiatric facilities, probation offices, etc.)

Required Advanced Training

- Integrated Forensic Peer Recovery Specialist training
- 4 days of virtual training focusing on several domains, including recovery and wellness, advocacy, mentoring and education, and ethical responsibility, among others
