# Emerging trends in prescribing buprenorphine: Tennessee 2015-2016

# Overview

**Buprenorphine** is a drug primarily used to treat opioid misuse disorder. It can also be used to treat pain.

## **Research questions:**

- How has the buprenorphine prescribing capacity in Tennessee changed between September 2015 and September 2016?
- How is the buprenorphine prescribing capacity related to opioid misuse disorder?



# **Executive Summary**

## **Opioid misuse disorder**

• In 35 counties, more than 200 people are estimated to misuse opioids, with a state total of about 30,394 adult Tennesseans.

### **Buprenorphine prescribers**

• The number of certified buprenorphine prescribers increased 13% from September 2015 (654 prescribers ) to September 2016 (737 prescribers).

### **Buprenorphine patient capacity**

• Buprenorphine patient capacity increased 47% from September 2015 (41,020 patients) to September 2016 (60,015 patients).

### **Opioid misuse disorder met by buprenorphine patient capacity**

• Buprenorphine patient capacity exceeded patient need in 23 counties.



# Changes in buprenorphine prescribing

### **Changes in law**

- In 2015, the DEA certified health care providers to prescribe buprenorphine at two patient capacity levels:
  - 30 patients
  - 100 patients
- On August 8, 2016, the federal law changed to three patient capacity levels:
  - 30 patients
  - 100 patients
  - 275 patients
- In January 2017, TDMHSAS started regulating buprenorphine clinics.

### **Current requirements**

- Buprenorphine prescribers complete an eight-hour course to become certified to treat up to 30 patients.
- After treating up to 30 patients for one year, the prescriber can request to increase the number of patients to 100.
- After treating up to 100 patients for one additional year, prescribers can request to increase the limit to 275 patients.



# Measuring patient capacity

 County-level patient capacity was calculated by summing all of the certified patient capacities (30, 100, 275) for all certified providers in a given county.

> (Number of prescribers certified up to 30 patients) X 30 + (Number of prescribers certified up to 100 patients) X 100 + (Number of prescribers certified up to 275 patients) X 275

= Maximum buprenorphine patient capacity

Note: Maximum buprenorphine patient capacity may or may not be used.

# Measuring treatment need

• **Opioid treatment need** = Number of people age 18 and older using opioids

for non-medical reasons X 14% (estimated opioid misuse disorder)



- Prevalence estimates of the number of people using heroin: *National Survey on Drug Use and Health, 2014-2015*
- County population (age 18+): American Community Survey, 2014
- Estimated percent (14%) of people using opioids for non-medical reasons that develop opioid misuse disorder: *National Institute on Drug Abuse, Monitoring the Future Survey (2011).*



### Estimated number of people who misuse opioids, 2012-2015






## Total number of prescribers increased 13% from 2015 to 2016


## Where are the certified buprenorphine prescribers?

## What counties had five or more certified buprenorphine providers in 2016?






## Total patient capacity increased 47% from 2015 to 2016


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
## Where is the buprenorphine patient capacity per 10k adults the greatest?

## What counties had a buprenorphine patient capacity over 200 in 2016?





# How has the number of buprenorphine prescribers and patient capacity changed from 2015 to 2016?



Percent change in patient capacity from September 2015 to September 2016






## In 2016, how did the buprenorphine patient capacity meet the need of people misusing or abusing opioids?








