### What is it?

A combination of on-the-job training and related classroom instruction provided under the supervision of a journey-level craft person or trade professional in which workers learn practical and theoretical aspects of a highly skilled occupation.

## How Do I Qualify?

- Apprenticeship training programs require a minimum of 2,000 hours of OJT per year, supplemented by a minimum of 144 hours related classroom instruction.
- Instruction may be given in a classroom, through correspondence courses, self-study, or other means of approved instruction.

#### What Do I Get?

- As an apprentice, you will receive training, education and wages from your employer.
- If you qualify for a GI Bill® program, you can also collect a monthly benefit payment 'in addition' to your regular full-time wages, for the duration of the apprentice training period. The amount of the GI Bill entitlement depends on your GI Bill eligibility.
- Total GI Bill benefits SMs can receive range from \$10-50K over a five year period.
