A Special Commission Conference will be held electronically via WebEx at **2:30 p.m. on Friday, March 27, 2020**. The Commission will convene an *en banc* session to consider the *Emergency Petition to Suspend Service Disconnections* filed on March 24, 2020 by the Consumer Advocate Unit of the Financial Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General in the above-captioned docket.

The ongoing state of public health emergency declared nationally, and by Tennessee Governor Bill Lee on March 12, 2020, places limitations on public gatherings and meetings in order to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). In convening the Special Conference electronically, without a physical quorum, the Commission relies on Governor Lee's Executive Order No. 16, and affirms that such is necessary to conduct the essential business of the agency and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of Tennesseans.
