Berrys Chapel Utility, Inc. (dba Harpeth Wastewater Cooperative) submits this weekly update to the Tennessee Public Utilities Commission's "Ongoing Request for Information Related to Measures Taken During the Coronavirus, COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" issued March 19, 2020.

The Berry's Chapel wastewater treatment and collection systems continue to operate normally at this time. Staff continues to monitor TDEC and CDC guidance for recommendations.
