Mr. Tubbs serves as Vice President, External and Customer Affairs for Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania and Maryland (CPA/CMD), and has overall responsibility for Regulatory, Government Affairs, Communications, Community Engagement and Municipal Relations in both states.

Mr. Tubbs previously held the position of Senior Counsel for NiSource Corporate Services Company (“NiSource”), and his practice was focused primarily on representing NiSource subsidiaries Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania and Columbia Gas of Maryland in matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Pennsylvania PUC”) and the Maryland Public Service Commission.

Prior to joining NiSource, Mr. Tubbs was an attorney in Post & Schell P.C.’s Energy Practice Group, where his practice focused on representing electric and gas utility clients in a variety of state and federal regulatory and transactional matters before the Pennsylvania PUC and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”). Mr. Tubbs has extensive state and federal

regulatory utility experience, including serving as an attorney for the Pennsylvania PUC where he provided representation before the state and federal appellate courts. He was actively involved in the Pennsylvania PUC’s efforts to restructure Pennsylvania’s electric and natural gas industries and served as one of the Commission’s primary counsels on federal energy matters before the FERC. In addition, during his tenure at the Pennsylvania PUC, Mr. Tubbs served as energy counsel for Pennsylvania Commissioner Kim Pizzigrilli. Prior to joining the Pennsylvania PUC, he served as in-house counsel for the Pennsylvania Rural Electric Association and Allegheny Electric Cooperative, Inc., where he advised the generation and transmission electric cooperative corporation and fourteen member trade association on matters involving utility law, employment law, environmental compliance, eminent domain proceedings, state and federal tax regulations, and contract drafting and negotiations. He also represented the Cooperative in matters before the FERC. Mr. Tubbs is admitted to practice in Pennsylvania and the U.S. District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania. He is a member of the Pennsylvania Bar Association. Mr. Tubbs earned a Bachelor of Arts from the University of Pittsburgh and his Juris Doctor from Widener University School of Law.
