Tennessee 811 and Staff Updates

A written update from Tennessee 811 was provided to the Committee before the meeting and Mr. Craig Ingram was available for questions. Mr. Ingram discussed an added line on the data report to highlight the number of days that pass between citation date and when 811 receives its first contact with a violator to schedule compliance training. With respect to requests made to 811 for emergency locates, Mr. Ingram clarified that generally emergency locates have to be made by phone.

There are 32 open investigations. The year to date total is 97. There were 4 administrative closures in February and 2 in March. The assessed civil penalty total is \$343,225 and the fund balance is \$199,435. The administrative and investigative position was reposted. The PHMSA grants are open. No applications had been received for the board's grant program. The Tennessee Gas Association submitted an invoice for their grant and will be showing the product to the board at the next meeting. The Committee briefly discussed the status of pending legislation and nature of some of the information provided regarding the legislation.
