Enactment Mineral Severance Tax Rate: Jackson County

Mineral Severance Tax Rate Enacted

Effective September 1, 2026, the governing body of Jackson County, Tennessee, has enacted a mineral severance tax of 20 cents per ton by means of a resolution approved by the county governing body. The new rate will apply to all sand, chert, sandstone, limestone, and gravel severed from the ground on or after September 1, 2026, by persons located in all areas of Jackson County, Tennessee.
