Instructions: Vapor Product Directory Certification

Beginning August 1, 2025, and by August 1st each year thereafter, every manufacturer of a vapor product that is sold for retail in Tennessee, whether directly or through an importer, wholesaler, distributor, retailer, or similar intermediary or intermediaries, must certify under penalty of perjury that the manufacturer is compliant with Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-4-1034.

Manufacturers must register each vapor product with the Department of Revenue using this form and pay a twenty-five-dollar (\$25.00) fee for each vapor product. Each vapor product with a separately identifiable SKU number indicates a vapor product subject to the fee. TOB 560 must be printed legibly or typed, and each field must be completed fully including listing the brand name, the category (e.g., consumable, power unit or device, vapor cartridge, pod, or disposable), the product name, flavor, and SKU. Indicate the representation number from page 1 for each product in the table.

This certification must also be accompanied by the following documents for each vapor product, as appropriate:

A copy of:

- The marketing granted order issued by the FDA pursuant to 21 U.S.C. Section 387j;
- The acceptance letter issued by the FDA pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 387j for a timely-filed premarket tobacco product application; or
- A document issued by the FDA or by a court confirming that the timely-filed premarket tobacco product application has received a denial order that has been and remains stayed by FDA or court order, rescinded by the FDA, or vacated by a court.

Taxpayers must submit their fully completed return online, along with the amount calculated from line 2, by visiting the Department's website at <https://tntap.tn.gov/eservices> prior to August 1st each year. An officer of the manufacturer must sign and date this annual certification online or physically sign the document if submitting by paper.
