Expiration Extension Notice

May 18th, 2020

Dear Tennessee Driver License and Handgun Carry Permit Holders,

Pursuant to Governor Bill Lee's Executive Order 36, signed May 12, 2020, the Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security has granted an extension to individuals with a Driver License, Learner Permit, and Photo Identification license set to expire between March 12, 2020 and June 29, 2020 or Enhanced Handgun Carry Permit set to expire between March 12, 2020 and June 30, 2020. The new expiration date will be November 15th, 2020. Individuals eligible for the extension are listed below:

Class D – Operators of regular passenger vehicles, pick-up trucks and vans;

Class M – Operator of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, or motorized bicycle/scooter;

Class PD – Instructional permit issued with a Class D license;

Class PM – Instructional permit issued with a Class M license;

Class ID – Photo Identification License;

Enhanced Handgun Carry Permit.

Please print a copy of this letter and maintain it with your expired license(s) or handgun carry permit.

YOU MUST KEEP THIS LETTER WITH YOU WHEN DRIVING TO PROVE THE VALIDITY OF YOUR LICENSE(S).
