## Graduated Driver Licenses





#### LEARNER PERMIT

#### **MINIMUM AGE: 15**

- Must be accompanied by licensed driver age 21 or older.
- Restricted from driving between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Driver and passengers 17 and under must wear seatbelts; age

3 and under must be in approved child restraint device.

# PENALTY FOR AT FAULT ACCIDENT OR VIOLATIONS

 Accumulation of six or more points (equivalent of two minor traffic citations) 180 days prior to applying for a restricted intermediate license extends learner permit period for an additional 90 days.

### PARENTAL NOTIFICATION

 Court required to notify parent or guardian of a conviction for moving violation or second seatbelt violation.

#### **EFFECTIVE**

• July 1, 2001.

#### **MINIMUM AGE: 16**

- Must hold learner permit for minimum of 180 days or licensed in another state for 90 days.
- Driver and all passengers 17
   and under must wear seatbelts;
   age 3 and under must be in approved child restraint device.
- Parent/guardian must submit certification that teen has accumulated 50 hours of driving experience, including 10 hours of night driving.
- Restricted from driving between hours of 11 p.m. and 6 a.m., unless accompanied by parent or guardian or licensed driver over twenty-one (21) designated by parent or legal





#### INTERMEDIATE RESTRICTED LICENSE

### guardian. LIMITED EXCEPTIONS

 Driver cannot have more than one passenger in the vehicle unless one or more passengers are 21 years or older. LIMITED EXCEPTIONS

# PENALTY FOR AT FAULT CRASH OR VIOLATIONS

 Accumulation of six or more points (equivalent of two minor traffic citations) or involvement in at-fault crash extends Intermediate Restricted period for an additional 90 days.

## PARENTAL NOTIFICATION

 Court required to notify parent or guardian of conviction for a moving violation or second seatbelt violation.

#### **EFFECTIVE**

• July 1, 2001.





INTERMEDIATE UNRESTRICTED LICENSE

#### **MINIMUM AGE: 17**

- Must have Restricted Intermediate License for one year prior to application.
- Cannot have accumulated 6 or more points, been involved in at-fault crash, or convicted of second seatbelt violation.

• Driver will continue to hold an Intermediate License but the license will indicate the restrictions have been removed.

#### **EFFECTIVE**

• July 1, 2001.
