2017 NEW YEAR'S HOLIDAY DECEMBER 30, 2016 – JANUARY 1, 2017 72-HOUR HOLIDAY PERIOD

- **FATAL CRASHES: 5**

All four crashes were single vehicle crashes, and none were multiple vehicle crashes.

- **FATALITIES: 5**

Two (40%) of the fatalities were alcohol-related.

Two (40%) of the people killed were motor vehicle occupants.

- Of the **three** occupant fatalities, **one (33%)** wore a safety restraint.
- **No** child passengers requiring a child restraint device were killed.
- **No** motorcyclists were killed.
- **No** pedalcyclists were killed.
- **Two** pedestrians were killed.
