STATE BUILDING COMMISSION June 12, 2025

Comment: This is a FY23/24 <u>line-item</u> project in the capital budget (Energy Saving Performance Contracts

\$50,000,000.00). Ten proposals were received on October 31, 2024. The Notice of Intent to award was sent on November 22, 2024 naming Ameresco, Inc. as the best evaluated proposer. No protests were received in the protest period. Ameresco, Inc. has completed an Investment Grade Audit and developed an Energy Savings Performance Contract Project Proposal. The Tennessee Department of Transportation is seeking approval to enter into an Energy Savings Performance Contract for the design, construction, and measurement and verification phases. The estimated maximum contract price is \$15,262,030.00 with a simple payback period of 19.7 years. The Energy Savings Performance Contracting delivery method includes design services thus the State will not be seeking a designer.

Minutes: 06/12/2025 SBC Lt. Governor McNally thanked Commissioner Eley for TDOT's efforts along

with the efforts of the Department of Safety, department of Homeland Security,
TBI and all those involved in helping with the Hurricane Helene cleanup and

restoration efforts in Upper East Tennessee.

Secretary Hargett stated that ESCO projects have been under discussion for several years and asked how long the current discussion had been underway. Commissioner Eley recalled that discussions of how to expedite project completion and cost estimating had been ongoing when he was a member of the SBC and improvements have been made on that front, and he believes this delivery method offers another tool in the toolbox to help tackle this challenge. In response to Secretary Hargett's follow-up question on the SBC's approval of ESCO projects, State Architect McGauran stated that the SBC approved the ESCO project delivery method in 2022 and funding for ESCOs was approved in the FY23 budget.
