## CAPITOL COMPLEX, NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE

Mr. Fitts presented a request for approval of a revision in the estimated project cost and 1) acknowledgment of the source of funding from \$6,400,000.00 to \$8,050,000.00 (\$1,650,000.00 increase) of a project for War Memorial Plaza Exterior Upgrades at Capitol Complex, approval of the Early Design Phase, and approval to fully plan the project within existing funds. He explained that the original project consists of the replacement of Plaza waterproofing to provide watertight conditions for protection of Legislative offices below. He said that this project includes the removal and replacement of all Plaza landscape material, installation of new lighting fixtures and replacement of handrails as required for code compliance. He added that Phase Two of the project includes waterproofing of the Charlotte Avenue tunnel and entrance. He introduced the designers who made the design presentation. Discussions ensued regarding the extensive cost of removing and replanting the same trees, an option the Commission agreed to as unfeasible. Mr. Fitts mentioned that the Capitol Commission had expressed concern over the slick surface of some of the Plaza pavers and had asked Mr. Fitts to investigate a solution. He reported that sandblasting them could be done at a cost of \$400,000. Comptroller Morgan suggested a discreet sign might be put up stating "slippery when wet". After further discussion, the Commission approved the request as presented.
