TENNESSEE SUPREME COURT, NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE

Mr. Fitts presented a request for approval to preplan a project for Renovation and Addition to the 1) Tennessee Supreme Court Building, Nashville, and selection of a designer to plan the project. The Speakers brought up the issue of preplanning projects before they are funded. Speaker Naifeh asked Mr. Fitts why this project needed to be on this agenda. Mr. Fitts responded that the request was by the Courts to begin preplanning. He said that the planning for this expansion could take longer than normal due to the complexity of the project which includes expansion and renovation and a complicated integration of two buildings. Secretary of State Darnell said the Library & Archives project and this project have been going on for ten or more years and this is a continuing study project identifying the sequence of things that have to happen. He said he thought this was the way to do it and he understands the Commission's concern about preplanning before funding. He said he thought that the Legislature would fund the Library & Archives, and possibly the Museum, before this project. He added that, if it gets to the point that the State Architect recommends funding, he will be ready to do that. Mr. Fitts said he thought monies could be requested for full planning in next year's budget request, and then full funding the following year. Secretary of State Darnell said they don't need to wait too long because it will impact the next step. Lieutenant Governor Wilder said he would like to know how many projects have been preplanned in the last ten years that did not get funded. He said he was ready to preplan any project that was ready to be built.

Justice Clark was recognized. She said she had listened to the questions and concerns and understands the funding limitations. She said the Court and judicial system understand that their desire to occupy this

building has to fall behind the Library & Archives' move, and that everybody in the judicial system certainly understands the approval of the preplanning dollars does not commit the Commission to full funding. She said their planning will take longer since they are now in three separate locations, and the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, the Court of Criminal Appeals, the Administrative Offices of the Courts, and the Bureau of Professional Responsibility will all have to be involved in the planning process. Lieutenant Governor Wilder said if she would tell him what the cost is to build these two buildings, that he would sponsor an amendment to fund them.

Speaker Naifeh asked about the \$500,000 of Supreme Court funds for planning. Justice Clark responded that there was not just a big pot of money that was sitting around unused. She said that they haven't totally identified where all the funds are coming from, but it would be coming from several different operating savings or from belt-tightening. Speaker Naifeh asked Mr. Fitts if he anticipated the \$500,000 to be enough to preplan the project. Mr. Fitts responded that the \$500,000 was not enough to preplan, but should be sufficient to develop a program and design concepts. Lieutenant Governor Wilder said he was ready to fund the \$50 million, but was just against spending \$500,000 and then not doing it.

After discussion, the request was approved along with the selection of the joint venture design team of Everton Oglesby Architects / Hastings Architecture Associates, to develop a program and design concepts for the project.
