1) Following a discussion involving the Capitol tunnel doors and heating problems on the first floor of the Capitol, the Commission approved a request by State Architect Mike Fitts to design and build security improvements as recommended by Homeland Security and the Department of Safety to provide a security station at the entrance to the tunnel to the State Capitol, thereby allowing the tunnel doors to be opened for access. The estimated cost for this work would be approximately \$100,000. The Commission referred to the Subcommittee, with authority to act, the selection of a designer, if needed, to design and supervise the work.

Mr. Fitts informed the Commission that the work involving waterproofing would preclude access to the exterior tunnel doors during the Legislative session unless the work was postponed. He recommended that they continue with the waterproofing work and build temporary stairs for pedestrian access to the Capitol from Charlotte Avenue. The Commission concurred in Mr. Fitts' recommendation.
