Deputy Commissioner Ray presented a request for approval to employ a cost consultant to provide cost verification on the Morgan County Correctional Facility Expansion project. Discussion ensued 1) regarding the need for a cost consultant. Mr. Fitts stated that the original estimate was prepared by a master plan done by a previous firm. He said that the current designer's estimate has come in at 26% higher than the previous estimate. He said that this consultant will verify the accuracy of the current estimate and, once that is done, they can complete their analysis of justification for any overages. Speaker Naifeh asked to what is this estimate compared. Larry Kirk responded that the last facility that the State built was the Lauderdale County facility which was occupied about ten years ago. Comptroller Morgan asked if this site was more expensive than the other prospective sites. Mr. Kirk responded that they were incurring some additional costs due to site conditions. He said that this was not necessarily the lowest first cost site they could have chosen. Speaker Naifeh asked if they were going to close Brushy Mountain, and Deputy Commissioner Ray said they were, as it is too costly to operate. Lieutenant Governor Wilder discussed the concept of working inmates and Commissioner Ray said she has been impressed with the farm operation and industries at Turney Center and would like to have the members visit the facility and view the operations. Governor Wilder said he would like to do that. He then cautioned the Department to take a look at this project and make sure they are getting value for monies spent. After general discussion, the Commission approved the selection of Hanscomb Faithful & Gould to assist the Department as a cost consultant on the project.
