Speaker Naifeh questioned why they didn't dig a well rather than run a pipe for 29 miles. Commissioner White said it was promised to Pikeville to improve the water situation. Speaker Naifeh asked if they had explored digging a well. Tom Giese was recognized and said that the engineer who did the study for this project had evaluated many ways, but did not examine digging wells at that depth. He said the current water supply at Taft is an impoundment on the local creek. Speaker Naifeh asked if Pikeville was going to be able to take advantage of the pipeline and will they pay for any of the expenses. Mr. Giese replied that they would not initially, but later will be paying as taps are added. Lieutenant Governor Wilder recommended that they refer the matter to the Subcommittee with authority to act. He added that the Subcommittee needs to determine if 29 miles is the thing to do when utilizing tax payers' money.

The Commission then approved Governor Wilder's recommendation by referring the matter to the Subcommittee, with authority to act.

Commissioner Virginia Betts requested action on the following matter.

#### SPECIAL ITEM

Commissioner Betts presented a request for approval of a project and acknowledgment of the source of funding for a replacement facility for the Memphis Mental Health Institute to be located at the Regional Medical Center in Memphis, Tennessee. She proceeded with a summary of the project, defining the roles of the State including the University of Tennessee and Memphis Mental Health Institute, Methodist and Shelby County. Treasurer Sims made a motion to approve the project in concept, as presented, contingent upon the execution of appropriate documentation and agreements by all parties, including review by SBC staff and the Attorney General's Office, with the resulting agreement(s) being reported to the SBC Executive Subcommittee. Furthermore, the recommended design professionals, architects and engineers, are subject to SBC approval and are delegated with approval authority to the SBC Designer Selection Subcommittee, which is next scheduled to meet on June 20 of this month.

Speaker Naifeh questioned the construction of only 75 beds as compared to the 90+ beds in the existing facility. Commissioner Betts responded that there is a nationwide trend of reduction in these types of beds and that the facilities at Western Mental Health Institute should be able to absorb any overage need in the long term. Speaker Naifeh questioned why the Shelby County delegation did not know about the project. He said he wasn't in the loop and didn't like the way it was brought up, but he would vote for it. He added that if another project comes up this way, he would not vote for it. Gary Shorb, CEO for Methodist Healthcare, said that they knew they needed the SBC to approve it first but they were trying not to overstep their bounds. Commissioner Betts and Goetz also apologized for the oversight. Lieutenant Governor Wilder commented that he and Speaker Naifeh are co-chairmen of the Commission and that, while this project looked like a good deal, he thought their staffs should've been involved.

Treasurer Sims stated that the Constitutional Officers have known of the initiative since December. He said the transaction before them was a unique opportunity and was in the best interest of the State. He added that he didn't like how they had gotten to where they were and that his support for this transaction was not to be construed as support for the way this had gotten to the SBC. He said that, in the future in dealing with such projects, they need to make sure that all the relevant parties are included and that he doesn't ever want to see themselves in this position again. Lieutenant Governor Wilder added that the Constitutional Officers were their staff, too, so their communicating to them is communicating to the SBC. The motion was then restated, seconded, and passed without further objection.

Mr. Shorb thanked the Commission and stated that this project will provide an extremely valuable service to the community. He said he wanted to thank Commissioner Betts and her staff as he thought this project speaks well of the State.
