SPECIAL ITEM

1) State Architect Mike Fitts reminded the Commission that the SBC had approved a project in 2007, along with consultants, for the development of **Tennessee Sustainable Design Guidelines** (TNSDG). He said a task force was formed that included representatives of Real Property Administration, University of Tennessee, Tennessee Board of Regents, Tennessee Higher Education Commission, State Architect's Office, and consultants, SSR, Inc. and Hastings Associates Architecture. He said the direction was to develop sustainable guidelines to be included in the Designers Manual for designers and State project managers on *all* projects. He added that one objective was to be comparable to existing minimum standards, primarily LEEDS, Green Globes and Energy Star programs, yet a system tailored to Tennessee and in Tennessee's best overall interest.

Mr. Fitts said the guidelines addressed the broad issues of land management, water efficiency, energy efficiency and atmospheric protection, material and resource use, and indoor environmental quality. The State and its selected design team will use the TNSDG checklist and scorecard containing *Required, Recommended* and *Optional* items. He said the Optional category would involve innovative credits for Tennessee specific objectives. He added that one advantage of the system was the relative ease it can be transitioned into any of the established sustainable standards, such as LEEDS, Green Globes and Energy Star, etc., if the State so desires.

The State project manager and selected designer will individually go over all items and check which items need to be addressed in any particular project. He said, overall, the guidelines will evaluate cost implications and reasonableness relative to Tennessee's objectives toward true, meaningful and feasible sustainable design objectives. He said one of the advantages of the Tennessee system is the fact that they would look at *all* projects regardless of size and scope. He said the intention was to use the TNSDG as a part of the department & agency's Designer Manual for all projects approved by the SBC beginning in March of 2008. He added that the departments and agencies may, on a selected basis, utilize the guidelines on projects that have previously been approved and are in the design phase.

After discussion, the Commission acknowledged the recommendations of the study and its implementation as outlined by Mr. Fitts.
