# WILLIAM R. SNODGRASS TENNESSEE TOWER, NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE

1) Mr. Fitts presented a request for approval of a revision in scope of a project for **Tenant Renovation** at William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, Nashville, in order to include general renovations within the existing project budget, and approval to utilize the Direct Order contract on a limited basis to accomplish the work. He stated that the revised scope was to provide renovations to accommodate the relocation of Edison staff to the Tower before their lease expires on December 31, 2009. He said the \$500,000 cost involves mostly furniture, of which less than \$100,000 would be charged to the Direct Order contract. Mr. Fitts added that the revised scope would also include meeting the future needs for the change in Administration, transition spaces and needs for relocation due to the Capitol improvements project.

Speaker Williams asked why the issue involving the Edison move had not been addressed earlier before it became critical. Assistant Commissioner Dottie Hagood responded that her staff had been working on it for months, but it was very complicated, and it was critical that the furniture procurement portion of this project be allowed to go forward. After further discussion, Commissioner Goetz made a motion to approve the \$500,000 scope change in order to allow the procurement of furniture to proceed without delaying the Edison move, and let the remaining scope change be referred to the Subcommittee, with authority to act, acknowledging the review of the plans by SBC staff. The motion was seconded, and passed without objection.
