CANCELLATION OF PROJECTS

While the Commission was supportive of the Administration's handling of the projects, they expressed concern that the Legislature may have a different understanding. Commissioner Goetz responded that higher education projects are more complicated as THEC has a different process. But for the other agencies, removing virtually all the money from these projects, in essence, cancels the projects. He added that the actions by the SBC in regards to these projects allows the Administration to keep project management and financial records accurately; to advise design firms that the projects they were selected on are not proceeding; and formally notifies departments the projects are not proceeding should they wish to reprioritize and request funding for these projects in the future. Assistant Commissioner Mark Drury requested action on the following matter.

<u>WEST TENNESSEE – HAYWOOD COUNTY</u>

Assistant Commissioner Mark Drury presented a request for approval of a grant to the Haywood County Mega Site Authority in the amount of \$40,300,000 for the purchase and development of land in Stanton, Haywood County, Tennessee. Mr. Drury made a brief presentation on behalf of Commissioner Kisber. He provided background on the megasite certification program and the overall benefits of the purchase of the land within the West Tennessee megasite to the local economy, surrounding counties and the State as a whole.

Secretary Hargett asked who the seven members of the Authority were, and was told that had not been decided yet. Lieutenant Governor Ramsey said he was 100% for this, but asked how can one obligate bonds to someone who doesn't exist. He further asked about the high land cost. Mr. Drury responded that the value of the property is associated with the ultimate industrial use of the land. Commissioner Goetz stated that the market is the market, and that the cost reflects the negotiation process used in lieu of condemnation. Comptroller Wilson commented that the price is basically \$10,600 per acre. He asked if the land had been identified and also if there was a preference whether the land goes to the Authority or the State. He said he wanted to do this right. He thought there were items that were resolvable, but he wanted to refer the matter to the Subcommittee with authority to act. Treasurer Lillard said that he didn't have a plat or defined area and, as a member of the Commission approving a \$40 million grant, he would like to see a final plat that they were approving. Commissioner Goetz commented that there is that kind of refinement that needs to be finalized and is the principle hold up. Comptroller Wilson said that the General Assembly has acted on this. He added that they have issues with the bonding that he wants resolved. Speaker Williams commented that they won't deal with all those options and he doesn't understand why they need to narrow down the land. He asked why it was taking so long to establish the Authority. Mr. Drury responded that it was his understanding there was a difference of opinions with the attorneys as to structuring the Authority. Speaker Williams urged that they be very careful and not do anything to jeopardize losing these options. Commissioner Goetz responded that this was all new and they had never done this before with a very technical bond issue. Treasurer Lillard commented that, as a West Tennessean, he was excited about the development and thought they should send it to the Subcommittee who could look at the issues in their fiduciary roles for the citizens of Tennessee. Secretary Hargett stated that he knew what a tremendous benefit this could be and he believed the Legislature made their feelings known. He said the important thing was to do it right, exercising their fiduciary responsibility. The Commission then referred the request to the Subcommittee, with authority to act.
