**Charter School Revocation Policy 6.110**

---

**The Background:**

The Charter School Revocation policy outlines the process and criteria the State Board will use when considering an appeal of an LEA's decision to revoke a charter agreement and when considering the revocation of a charter agreement where the State Board serves as the chartering authority.

A review of all the State Board's charter school authorizer policies was conducted to ensure alignment with updates to the High Quality Charter Schools Act and the development of the Tennessee state charter school authorizing standards. Additionally, now that the State Board has authorized charter schools in operation, updates were needed to better reflect current practices.

This policy has been updated to clarify timelines in the revocation process and to further define the process for signing up for and giving public comment at the public hearing. There have also been minor grammatical and formatting edits.

**The Recommendation:**

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
