
Charter School Core Authorizing Principles Policy 6.200

The Background:

The Core Authorizing Principles policy affirms the State Board's mission with regard to its authorizing functions as set forth in State Board Policy 6.100.

A review of all the State Board's charter school authorizer policies was conducted to ensure alignment with updates to the High Quality Charter Schools Act and the development of the Tennessee state charter school authorizing standards. Additionally, now that the State Board has authorized charter schools in operation, updates were needed to better reflect current practices.

This policy has been updated to reflect language included in State Board Policy 6.111 – Quality Authorizing Standards. There have also been minor grammatical and formatting edits.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
