
Charter School Intervention Policy 6.700

The Background:

The Charter School Intervention policy sets forth the criteria and process for charter school intervention decisions and actions by the State Board.

A review of all the State Board's charter school authorizer policies was conducted to ensure alignment with updates to the High Quality Charter Schools Act and the development of the Tennessee state charter school authorizing standards. Additionally, now that the State Board has authorized charter schools in operation, updates have been made to better reflect our current practices.

This policy has been updated to remove "suspension" of a charter agreement as a possible intervention action since this is not permitted under statute and to clarify the actions and consequences for a charter school's inclusion on the Department of Education's Priority School List. There have also been minor grammatical and formatting edits.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
