
Charter School Intervention Policy 6.700

The Background:

The Charter School Intervention policy sets forth the criteria and process for authorized charter school intervention decisions and actions by the State Board.

A review of all the State Board's charter school authorizer policies was conducted to ensure alignment with updates to the High Quality Charter Schools Act and the development of the Tennessee state charter school authorizing standards. Additionally, now that the State Board has authorized charter schools in operation, updates have been made to better reflect our current practices.

This policy has been updated on page 4 under Level 3 Notice of Probationary Status to close gaps in the requirements and allow maximum flexibility for the State Board to intervene.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
