
Career and Technical Education, Rule 0520-01-07

The Background:

To ensure consistency in messaging and language across the State Board of Education Rule 0520-01-03-.06 and the State Board's Work-Based Learning (WBL) Framework, this item proposes changes to include Work-Based Learning language.

Below is a brief summary of the changes (page numbers reflect the tracked changes document):

- **Page 2:** Replaces the term "work experience" with "work-based learning" in both the title and the body of rule 0520-01-07-.03.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the term "training" with "work-based learning" in the body of rule 0520-01-07-.03.
- **Page 2:** Replace the term "cooperative work experience" with "work-based learning experience" in the title of rule 0520-01-07-.04.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the term "Teacher" with "Work-based learning" in sub-section (1) of rule 0520-01-07-.04.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the phrase "on-the-job training through part-time employment" with "work-based learning placements" in sub-section (1) of rule 0520-01-07-.04.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the term "cooperative" with "work-based learning" in sub-section (2) of rule 0520-01-07-.04.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the phrase "the cooperative education teacher" with "a certified work-based learning coordinator" in sub-section (2) of rule 0520-01-07-.04.
- **Page 2:** Replaces the term "cooperative" with "work-based learning" in sub-section (2) of rule 0520-01-07-.04.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:
