STANDARD OF REVIEW

- Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) § 49-13-122(f):

*In order to overturn an LEA's decision to revoke or not to renew a charter agreement, **the state board must find that such decision was contrary to T.C.A. § 49-13-122.***

- T.C.A. § 49-13-122(b):

A public charter school agreement may be revoked at any time or not renewed by the final chartering authority if the chartering authority determines that the school:

(1) Committed a material violation of any conditions, standards, or procedures set forth in the charter agreement;

(2) Failed to meet or make sufficient progress toward the performance expectations set forth in the charter agreement; or

(3) Failed to meet generally accepted standards of fiscal management.
