1. There is insufficient evidence that the EPP evaluates mentor teachers.

The provider demonstrates that the quality of candidates is a continuing and purposeful part of its responsibility from recruitment, at admission, through the progression of courses and clinical experiences, and to decisions that completers are prepared to teach effectively and are recommended for certification. This process is ultimately determined by a program's meeting of Standard 4.

1. The recruitment plan lacks specificity particularly in identifying recruitment goals.
