Final Reading Item: IV. G.

Charter School Revocation & Revocation Appeals Policy 6.110

The Background:

The Charter School Revocation policy outlines the process and criteria the State Board will use when considering an appeal of an LEA's decision to revoke a charter agreement and when considering the revocation of a charter agreement where the State Board serves as the authorizer.

Updates to this policy reflect changes passed in the 111th General Assembly.

There have been no changes since first reading.

Policy Justification:

T.C.A. § 4-5-230 requires that justification for adopting an item as a policy instead of a rule be submitted to the chair of the Government Operations Committee. This item is proposed to be adopted as a policy because it defines or explains the meaning of a statute or rule and/or concerns only the internal management of state government that does not affect private rights or privileges.

The Recommendation:

State Board of Education staff recommends approval of this item on final reading.
