
Charter School Intervention Policy 6.700

The Background:

The Charter School Intervention policy sets forth the criteria and process for intervention decisions and actions by the State Board for its authorized charter schools.

Updates to this policy reflect changes passed in the 111th General Assembly regarding the Priority School List.

There have been no changes since first reading.

Policy Justification:

T.C.A. § 4-5-230 requires that justification for adopting an item as a policy instead of a rule be submitted to the chair of the Government Operations Committee. This item is proposed to be adopted as a policy because it defines or explains the meaning of a statute or rule and/or concerns only the internal management of state government that does not affect private rights or privileges.

The Recommendation:

State Board of Education staff recommends approval of this item on final reading.
