## Christopher Comer Voluntary Surrender

## The Background:

- Facts:Mr. Comer was reported for engaging in inappropriate communications with students via<br/>various messaging platforms. The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation investigated Mr.<br/>Comer's conduct, but ultimately no criminal charges were filed against him. The<br/>Tennessee Bureau of Investigation records are confidential.
- *Status:* Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to permanently revoke his educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

## The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for permanent license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3)(g), (3)(h), (5)(a)(5)(i), (5)(a)(5)(i), and (5)(a)(8).

The Board staff recommended the permanent revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license. Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender his license and not reapply for restoration of his license. The Board staff recommends that the Board approve the signed Consent Order submitted by the Respondent for the surrender of his license.
