Revocation – Automatic, Permanent

The Background:

Facts: On October 10, 2018, Mr. Weir pleaded guilty to one count of Statutory Rape by an Authority Figure, a class C felony, one count of Aggravated Statutory Rape, a class D felony, and Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, a class D felony, in the Criminal Court of Coffee County, Tennessee. He was sentenced to 2 years in TDOC custody for each count, to run concurrently. Upon release, Mr. Weir will have to register on the sex offender registry for the duration of his life.

Status: Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a)(1).

The Board staff recommends the automatic, permanent revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license.
