Students shall have access to a system of structured work-based learning (WBL) experiences that allow them to apply classroom theories to practical problems as well as explore career options.<sup>1</sup>

Each authorized charter school shall adopt procedures to govern the efficient administration of the WBL program in accordance with State Board Policy 2.103. Such procedures shall include, among other things, a process for evaluation and assessment of the program to ensure that it is of high quality and meets the needs of students.
