Revocation – automatic

The Background:

Facts: Ms. Wilson was arrested and charged with DUI and Vehicular Homicide. She ultimately pled guilty to one count of Vehicular Homicide by Intoxication, a class B felony. She was sentenced to eight years in prison.

Status: Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke her educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for automatic license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(4)(a).

The Board staff recommends the automatic revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license.
