
Charter School Quality Charter Authorizing Standards Policy 6.111

The Background:

Pursuant to T.C.A. § 49-13-108, chartering authorities are required to adopt policies and practices for quality charter school authorizing standards as approved by the State Board of Education. State Board Policy 6.111 sets forth the essential practices that shall govern the day-to-day operation of charter authorizers in the state.

These standards were developed in collaboration with the National Association of Charter School Authorizers (NACSA) and were originally adopted by the State Board in 2018. The State Board is committed to regularly evaluating the standards to ensure they are aligned to national best practices and the needs of Tennessee.

No changes have been made since first reading of this item.

The Recommendation:
