

**Jermaine Johnson

**The Background:**

*Facts:* Mr. Johnson's license was revoked in 2014 for paying a surrogate to take his PRAXIS exam. Mr. Johnson has since taken and passed the part of the exam he previously paid someone to take for him. Mr. Johnson has not taught since then, but he has gotten more schooling and training in support of his teaching career. He has three letters of reference in support of the restoration of his license.

*Status:* Respondent was notified by electronic mail on May 1, 2019, of the Board staff's recommendation to grant restoration of his license at the Board's next regularly scheduled meeting.

**The Recommendation:**

Pursuant to Board Policy 5.500, the Board staff recommends that Educator's license be restored based upon the policy considerations deemed relevant by the Board to show that an educator has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant license restoration.
