

**Emily Tubb
Restoration**

The Background:

Facts: Ms. Tubb's license was revoked on August 5, 2011, based upon her federal conviction for Possession with Intent to Distribute (a felony) in Mississippi. The conviction arose out of her addiction to opioids. She has completed treatment for her drug addiction and her term of supervised probation. In the interim, she has been working for a local newspaper in Mississippi. Ms. Tubb has submitted multiple letters of support on her behalf.

Status: Respondent was notified by electronic mail on March 4, 2019, of the Board staff's recommendation to grant restoration of her license at the Board's next regularly scheduled meeting.

The Recommendation:

Pursuant to Board Policy 5.500, the Board staff recommends that Educator's license be restored based upon the policy considerations deemed relevant by the Board to show that an educator has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant license restoration.
