

**Walter McCrimmon  
Voluntary Surrender\***

**The Background:**

*Facts:* On April 6, 2017, Mr. McCrimmon pleaded guilty to one count of money laundering (a class C felony), pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 39-12-101, and one count of promoting prostitution (a class E felony), pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 39-15-515, in the Criminal Court for Shelby County, Tennessee. Mr. McCrimmon was ordered diversion and was sentenced to four (4) years of supervised probation from April 6, 2017, through April 6, 2021.

*Status:* Respondent was notified by certified mail and email of the Board's intent to revoke his educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

**The Recommendation:**

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(2)(a) and (2)(f).

The Board staff recommended the revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license. Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender his license and not reapply for restoration of his license for a period of five (5) years from the date of approval of the signed Consent Order. The Board staff recommends that the Board approve the signed Consent Order submitted by the Respondent for the surrender of his license.
