

**Jonathan Isley
Voluntary Surrender**

The Background:

Facts: Mr. Isley was reported by Marshall County Schools after he was charged with aggravated statutory rape. On June 19, 2019, Mr. Isley pleaded guilty the amended charge of statutory rape (a class E felony) pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 39-13-506 in the Criminal Court for Marshall County, Tennessee. Mr. Isley was granted judicial diversion and was ordered to two years of supervised probation.

Status: Respondent was notified by certified mail of the Board's intent to revoke his educator license based upon these findings. Respondent received said notice.

The Recommendation:

Respondent's conduct constitutes grounds for license revocation pursuant to Board Rule 0520-02-03-.09(3)(e), (3)(g), (3)(h), (5)(a)(6)(ii), and (5)(a)(8).

The Board staff recommended the revocation of Respondent's Tennessee educator license. Respondent agreed to voluntarily surrender his license and not reapply for restoration of his license. The Board staff recommends that the Board approve the signed Consent Order submitted by the Respondent for the surrender of his license.
