
Compass Community Schools - Midtown Amendment Appeal

The Background:

Compass Community Schools – Midtown (Compass – Midtown) submitted an amendment petition to change its grade configuration to Shelby County Schools (SCS) on February 14, 2020. After reviewing the amendment petition, the SCS Office of Charter Schools recommended denial of the amendment petition.

On April 28, 2020, the SCS Board of Education discussed the amendment petition at the regularly scheduled board meeting and voted to send the amendment back to committee. The SCS Board of Education met again on May 11, 2020 and voted to deny the amendment petition.

On May 21, 2020, Compass – Midtown appealed to the State Board of Education (State Board). The State Board staff conducted a de novo on the record review of the amendment petition and held a virtual public hearing on July 8, 2020.

The Executive Director’s recommendation is based on the review of the record, information presented at the public hearing, and the public comment received this appeal.
