
Repeal Charter School Revocation & Revocation Appeals Policy 6.110

The Background:

State Board Policy 6.110 sets forth the criteria and process the State Board uses when considering an appeal of a local board of education's decision to revoke a charter agreement and when considering the revocation of a charter agreement where the State Board serves as the authorizer. In April 2019, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 219 creating the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (Commission) and transferring charter school revocation appeal and authorizing responsibilities from the State Board of Education to the newly created Commission effective January 1, 2021.

The Commission has approved rules and policies to govern its process for handling revocation appeals and its responsibilities as an authorizer which became effective in January 2021. In order to complete the transition of appeal authority to the Commission in compliance with Public Chapter 219, this item proposes a repeal of State Board of Education policy 6.110.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends approval of this item on final reading.
