

Repeal Core Authorizing Principles Policy 6.200

The Background:

State Board Policy 6.200 affirms the State Board's mission with regard to its authorizing functions set forth in State Board Policy 6.100. In April 2019, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 219 which created the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (Commission) and transferred the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission effective July 1, 2021.

The Commission has approved rules and policies which govern its work as a charter school authorizer and LEA. In order to complete the transition of the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission in compliance with Public Chapter 219, this item proposes a repeal of State Board Policy 6.200.

The Recommendation:

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
