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**Repeal Charter Agreements Policy 6.400**

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**The Background:**

State Board Policy 6.400 sets the guidelines for the State Board as it enters into charter agreements with the charter schools it authorizes and serves as the chartering authority in order to articulate the rights and responsibilities of each party during the charter term. In April 2019, the Tennessee General Assembly passed Public Chapter 219 creating the Tennessee Public Charter School Commission (Commission) and transferred the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission effective July 1, 2021.

The Commission has approved rules and policies to govern its work as a charter school authorizer and LEA. In order to complete the transition of the State Board's authorized charter schools to the Commission in compliance with Public Chapter 219, this item proposes a repeal of State Board Policy 6.400.

**The Recommendation:**

State Board staff recommends acceptance of this item on first reading.
