



Tennessee High School Equivalency Diploma Checklist

Adult Tennesseans (aged 18 years or older, or 17 years with local school superintendent approval) may receive an official high school equivalency diploma by completing the criteria outlined below.

Complete ONE of the following:

- Pass the HiSET exam (all 5 subjects)
- Attain a TCAT diploma or program certificate

Or, demonstrate math, reading, writing, science, and social studies competencies by completing the following:
