

2023-24 Special Courses Approval

The Background:

State Board of Education Rule 0520-01-03-.05(2) and Special Courses Policy 3.201 allow local education agencies (LEAs) to apply to offer special courses not listed in the State Board's Approved High School Courses Policy 3.205. The Department of Education annually reviews special course and special program of study applications submitted by LEAs and public charter schools and recommends special course approvals to the State Board of Education. Special courses may be approved for one (1), three (3), or six (6) years in accordance with State Board policy.

This item presents for the Board's approval the list of all special course applications received by the Department for the 2023-24 school year, along with their approval recommendation and, if applicable, the number of years for which the special course is recommended for approval.

The Fiscal Analysis Impact:

T.C.A. § 49-1-212 requires that the Department prepare a fiscal analysis of any policy, rule, or regulation proposed to the State Board of Education. This item has no financial impact on an LEA.

This item supports the State Board's strategic focus on Postsecondary and Career outlined in the Master Plan by providing LEAs and public charters the opportunity to provide their students with innovative course options.
