
Virtual Education Program Annual Report

The Background:

Annually by July 1, the Tennessee Department of Education is required by law to provide a detailed report on the operation of virtual education programs to the Governor, General Assembly, and the State Board. This year's report provides information relative to the operation and viability of public virtual schools and virtual education programs for the 2022-23 school year.

Connection to the Master Plan:

This item supports the State Board's strategic focus on Engagement and Accountability outlined in the Master Plan by providing a public report on the health and academic outcomes of the 59 public virtual schools operating in the 2022-23 school year. State Board Rule 0520-01-03-.05 sets forth requirements for the establishment, operation, and oversight of virtual schools and virtual education programs in Tennessee.
