

Master Plan Supplement

The Background:

T.C.A. § 49-1-302 requires the State Board to “develop and maintain current a master plan for the development of public education, kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12)...”

Approved by the State Board in November 2022, the 2022-2025 Master Plan provides a lens through which all stakeholders can examine state-level efforts to determine if rules and policies are positioning school districts to prepare Tennessee students for workforce, post-secondary success, and productive citizenship. The Master Plan includes two (2) documents: a main document with the strategic focus areas and action steps defined, and a supplement which provides relevant data and strategies to be employed by the State Board to achieve its goals.

This item makes changes to the supplement only with updated data outcomes based on the 2022-23 school year. The document contains the same data that was included in the State Board’s Master Plan Report, which the State Board approved at its November 2023 meeting.
